



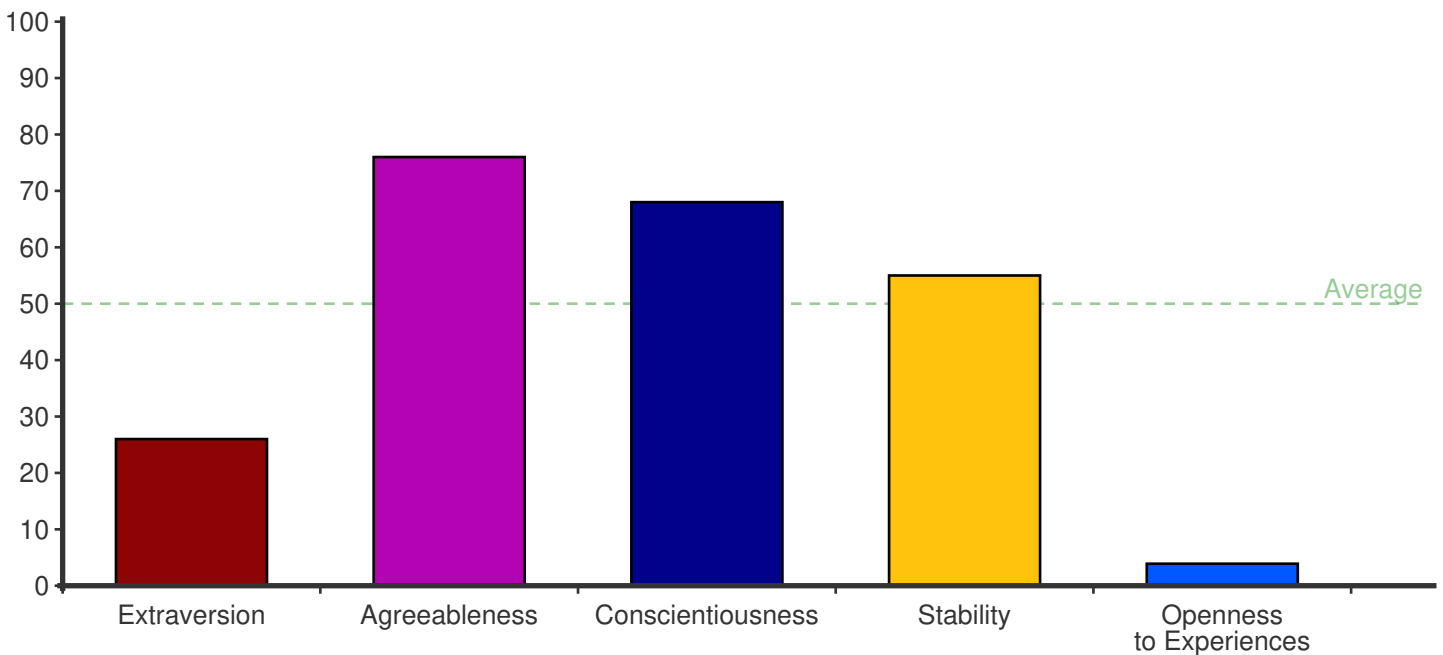

Scoring and Interpretation Information

Scores for each factor (ranging from 1 to 7) represent the average of that factor's two items. Higher scores indicate greater levels of that personality characteristic. Scores are also presented as percentile ranks based on combined gender-normed data, where the 50th percentile represents average responses relative to the comparison group. Each factor is



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assessed using the following items:

- Extraversion (Items 1, 6) Measures sociability, assertiveness, and energy level
Higher scores: Outgoing, talkative, socially confident
Lower scores: Reserved, quiet, prefers solitude

- Agreeableness (Items 2*, 7) Assesses interpersonal orientation and cooperation
Higher scores: Trusting, helpful, empathetic
Lower scores: Sceptical, competitive, self-focused

- Conscientiousness (Items 3, 8*) Evaluates self-discipline, organization, and goal-directed behaviour
Higher scores: Reliable, organized, persistent
Lower scores: Impulsive, disorganized, flexible

- Emotional Stability (Items 4*, 9) Measures emotional regulation and stress tolerance
Higher scores: Calm, secure, resilient
Lower scores: Anxious, moody, stress-reactive

- Openness to Experience (Items 5, 10*) Assesses intellectual curiosity and aesthetic appreciation
Higher scores: Creative, curious, open to new ideas
Lower scores: Conventional, practical, prefers routine

*Reverse-scored items (2, 4, 6, 8, 10)

Low scores on Emotional Stability have been shown to correlate with psychopathology while higher extraversion and agreeableness is correlated with psychological well-being (Lamers et al., 2012).
